Information from asset, maintenance and development activities is captured consistently and maintained through clear processes and ownership. Data remains complete, accessible and up to date throughout its lifecycle, protecting the integrity of core asset records.

Investment planning, financial forecasting and asset appraisal activity are supported by reliable data and robust assumptions. Decision makers can rely on the information available when prioritising resources, evaluating options and planning future investment, helping ensure homes, assets and budgets are managed effectively and sustainably.

Policies, procedures and system management standards remain clear, practical and consistently applied because effective guidance and oversight are in place. 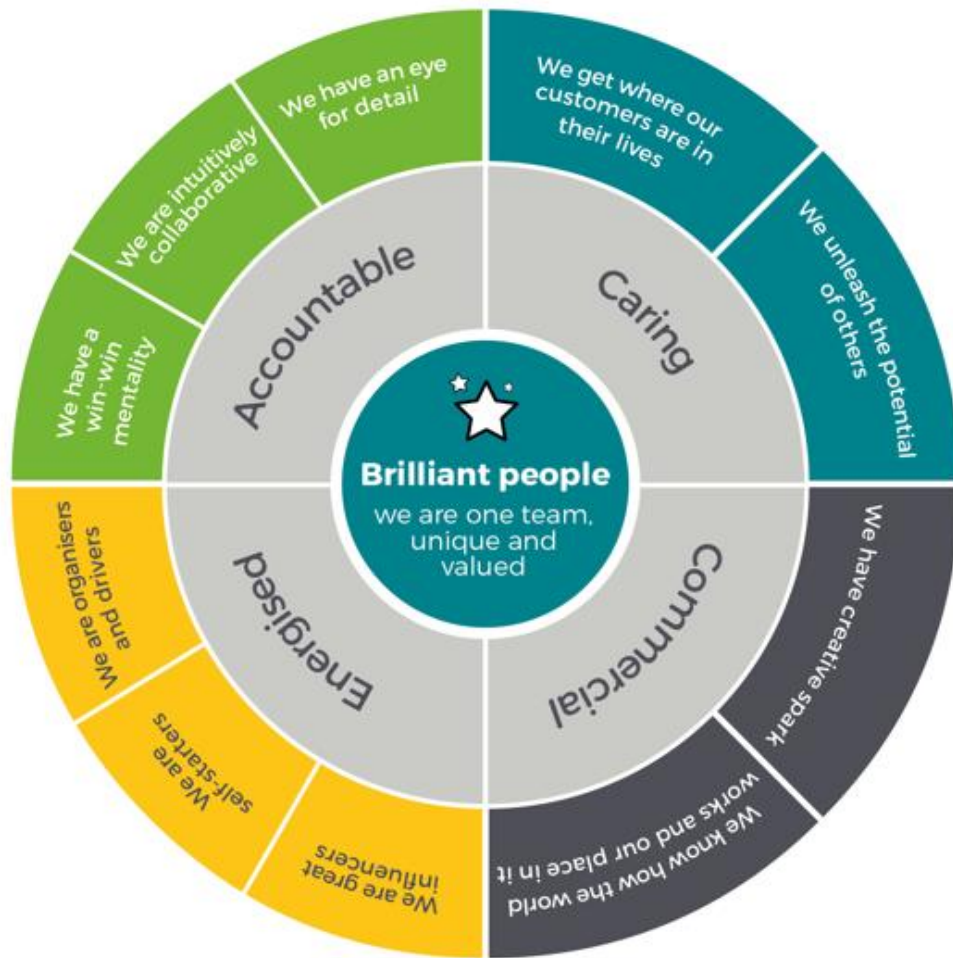
