Experience of the practical application of PBS including functional behavioural assessment, writing reports and the implementation of PBS plans.

Demonstrable experience of developing/delivering training and coaching in your area of expertise with a willingness to continue study in the specialist areas of learning disability, autistic spectrum conditions, mental health and PBS.
